1823-25	John BRADY, C, Hooghley 1825, 7 years, Gov serv to JP Webber, Newcastle.
1828	John BRADY, Catholic, labourer, Hooghley 1825, age 36 years, sentence 7 years, to JP Webber, Markham [Tocal], Patersons Plains. Note: this entry is problematic in that age differs from shipping indent by about 6 years, and sentence is actually 'life'. There was also a John BRAY on the Hooghley in 1825, with a 7 year sentence, but aged 18. Therefore the Census entry very likely refers to Brady/Brearily despite the errors in age and sentence.
