<p>Marriage Banns, 4/2481.93 [reel 737]. Letter from RM Clarke [Tocal's overseer] as follows: "Tocal March 26 1840 John Kidd was an assigned servant of mine from his arrival in the Colony until he obtained a Ticket of Leave about four years since he received a letter from his Brother in England Informing him of the Death of his Wife some time previous. From having read the letter myself I can with safety state this to be a fact, and if Necessary would state the same by Affidavit. Yours truly R.M.
