6 February 1829. Lawrence Mooney *Mangles* 1828, admitted to *Phoenix* Hulk, #1938, from Wallis Plains General Sessions on 2 February 1829 sentenced to three years for highway robbery. SR Phoenix Hulk Entrance Book. 4/6281 p80 [reel 819].

22 February 1832. Lawrence Mooney *Mangles* 5, admitted to *Phoenix* hulk, #129, from Moreton Bay per HM Schooner *Isabella* because his colonial sentence had expired. Disposed to Hyde Park Barracks 28 Feb 1832. SR Phoenix Hulk Entrance Book, 4/6282 [reel 819].

4 April 1832. Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles*, in the service of Thomas Campbell, insolence, reprimanded and discharged. Campbelltown Bench 1832-37, ML MSS 2482/6 [reel CY954].

6 November 1833 NSW GG p466. Runaway apprehended. Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles* (5), from No. 8 Road Party.

February 1835. NSW GG 25 February 1835 p118. Runaway apprehended, Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles* (3), from Hyde Park Barracks.

March 1836. NSW GG 23 March 1836 p269. Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles*, 28-827, 33, Meath, Carter, absconded from Gibraltar Road Party since March 14.

April 1836. NSW GG 6 April 1836 p310. Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles*, apprehended, runaway from Gibraltar Road Party.

4 April 1836. SR 4/5667 Sutton Forest Bench Books 1833-1836, p322. Sutton Forest Petty Sessions 4 April 1836. Lawrence Mooney, *Mangles* 1829, life, Gibraltar Gang, absconding, brought up by warrant from Clifton, absconded on 14 March, 50 lashes and returned to gang.

31 October 1836 admitted to the Phoenix Hulk from Hyde Park Barracks as witness in the case of Rex v's Whalas (?), disposed to Hyde Park Barracks 3 November 1836. SR Phoenix Hulk Entrance Book 4/6286 p102 #477 [reel 819].

8 February 1839. SR Sydney Gaol Entrance Book 1838-1839, 4/6438 [reel 853]. Admitted (#293) from Liverpool for examination. Out – examined to Liverpool 3 May 1839. SR. Phoenix Hulk Entrance Book 1833-1848, 4/6445 [reel 820]. Lawrence Mooney, colonial conviction Campbelltown 7 May 1839, cattle stealing with other. Sentence: PS 10 years Norfolk Island, forwarded 10 July 1839.

17 May 1838. SR Sydney Gaol Entrance Book 1838-1839, 4/6438 [reel 853]. Admitted from Campbelltown QS for 15 years transportation. Disposed, transported to N. Island 10 July 1839. [similar entry at X843, reel 1864].

8 August 1845. NSWGG p841. Absconded... Mooney Lawrence, *Mangles* 1828, 45, Meath, carter... from Domain gang attached to Hyde Park Barracks, since 1st instant.
