Assignment

On arrival to JP Webber, Patersons Plains, as per indent (HO10/29 says Paterson's River). Note: there is a well established pattern on the indents of this period where John Webber is recorded as JP Webber, Penshurst, and James Webber as JP Webber Patersons Plains (or Paterson River). His assignment to James Webber is confirmed by the transfer to Cassilis. In April 1834, transferred to Capt WH Clarke at Cassilis (see 'other' below).
