<b>1822 Jan 28</b>	On list of convicts landed from the "Mary" & forwarded to Windsor for distribution; listed as Shone (Reel 6008; 4/3504A p.358)
<b>1824 Jan 14</b>	Servant of William Noble of Sydney. Permitted to proceed with cattle through the Cowpastures & Argyle to the country to the southwest of the Cookbundoon Range; appears as Shawn (Reel 6012; 4/3510 p.178)
<b>1824 Feb 16</b>	Assigned servant of William Noble. Permitted to pass from Windsor, with cattle, to the farm of John Earle in the Country of Durham; appears as Schawn (Reel 6012; 4/3510 p.339)
<b>1824 Oct 4</b>	On monthly return of convicts assigned in the Counties of Northumberland & Durham; to J P Webber from Government, the Newcastle establishment. Listed as Shaw (Reel 6028; 2/8283 p.95).
