There is Col Sec correspondence referring to John Smith (Phoenix) but there were three of them on the Phoenix and it is not possible to attribute it to particular individuals. This correspondence is not significant and has not been entered.
There is also a colonial offence for John Smith, Phoenix which has not been entered – 25 lashes for being absent without leave, 5 March 1830, Sydney Bench of Magistrates X822 [reel 661].
