NSW GG 25 June 1834 p439. One of two 'laborers' transferred from JP Webber to Capt Clarke. [This followed the sale of Webber's Munnmurra Station at Cassilis to Clarke. Styles is not mentioned in the GG by name, but has been identified by datamatching].
