10 October 1836. John Williams, <i>Georgiana</i> , on board the Hulk, under orders for Port Macquarie, to be embarked on board William the Fourth. SR, CSLS to the Sheriff, 4/3900 p36 [reel 1064]. [see note about this in 'other' below]. There is correspondence relating to John Williams (Georgiana 1831) which has not been entered here because it is not possible to identify which John Williams it refers to. Similarly there is correspondence re John Williams, no ship stated, which has not been entered.

NSW muster

1837	(not found – there is an entry for John Williams, Georgiana 1828, age 63, Newcastle Gaol. The Georgiana carried convicts to VDL in 1829, so this entry is more likely for one of those. In any event, the age is too different).

SR, Phoenix Hulk Entrance Book 1833-1837, 4/6286 [reel 819]. John William, Georgiana 1829, cath, labourer, 14 years, admitted to hulk 26 August 1836 from Hyde Park Barracks to be invalided to Port Macquarie. Sent to Port Macquarie 11 October 1836. [Some of the details do not match and it may not be the correct person, but Tocal's John Williams, Georgiana, died at Port Macquarie in 1846 as noted on his indent, so this entry cannot be dismissed.]
